ABOUT THE PROGRAM

UNO is piloting a Faculty-Industry Engagement Program, the first of its kind in Louisiana. An immersive 2-4-week experience, it is intended to uncover collaborative opportunities between your organization and UNO, for mutual benefit.

The Division of Professional, Adult, and Continuing Education (PACE) and Office of Experiential Learning and Community Engagement (ELCE) will facilitate the process of matching organization and project hosts with prospective faculty advisors, and in collaboration with your organization, will steward project development and execution. The engagement will culminate in participating advisors developing a PACE course proposal.

Participation Timeline:

Month	Topic
Apr-May	Invitation to host projects sent to organizations. UNO faculty complete application process.
May-Jun	Organizations agree to host. Projects identified and outlined. Faculty are matched with partner organizations and meet with project sponsors.
Jun-Aug	Summer engagements commence. 45-hours or equivalent completed over 2-4 weeks during June or July. Course proposals submitted in August.
